

JUNIOR DRUM SET (DRM-312) ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Thank you for purchasing this great Drum Set from Austin Bazaar! Little drummers will really rock with this authentically styled, great-sounding Drum Set. Assembly is easy, and no additional tools are required.

Getting Started

Begin by checking the components of your set against the following list of included items (see below). This will help you identify each item. The sides of the drums and the retaining rings may be covered with a clear protective film. To remove the film, start at a loose edge and peel it away.

Then, follow the easy assembly instructions on page 2 (see below). Your drum set will be ready to play in just a few beats!

Included Items

The following items should be included in your drum set:

1. Cymbal (CY)
2. Snare Drum (SD)
3. Tom-Tom (TT)
4. Pedal Assembly (P)
5. Retaining Rings (x2) (R)
6. Drumheads (x2) (H)
7. Bass Drum
8. Spurs (x2) (S)
9. Drumsticks (x2)
10. Cymbal Post (CA)
11. Tom-Tom Support (TA)
12. Snare Drum Support (TA)
14. Tuning Tool
15. Tension Clamps (x12)



Assembly

- 1.) Set a drumhead on top of the bass drum wall with the rounded side facing up. Place a retaining ring on top and use six of the tension clips to secure it in place. Use the tuning tool to tighten all six of the tension clamps evenly.



- 2.) Repeat step 1 on the other side of the bass drum.
- 3.) Insert the spurs into the brackets on the bass drum. Set the drum on its side and adjust the length of the spurs so that the drum sits flat on the floor, and doesn't tip from side to side. Tighten the wing nuts to secure the spurs.



- 4.) Insert the bass drum mallet into the bracket on the pedal assembly and tighten the wing nut to hold it in place. Snap the hole in the metal bar over the post on the base and slide the bar forward so that the post fits into the notch. Do not tighten the wing nut on the clamp yet.
- 5.) Clamp the pedal assembly to the edge of the bass drum on the opposite side of the spurs. Tighten the wing nut to secure the clamp. You should now be able to depress the bass drum pedal, and the beater will strike the drum head.
- 6.) Insert the long end of the snare drum support into the bracket on the bass drum (on the left side if you're positioned behind the drum set). Insert the other end into the bracket on snare drum. Adjust the position of the snare drum and tighten the wing nuts.



- 7.) Insert the long end of the tom-tom support into the bracket on the bass drum (on the right side if you're positioned behind the drum set). Insert the other end into the bracket on tom-tom. Adjust the position of the tom-tom and tighten the wing nuts.
- 8.) Remove the wing nut and felt washer from the cymbal post. Slide the cymbal onto the post (above the remaining felt washer), replace the other felt washer and secure with the wing nut.
- 9.) Insert the cymbal post into the bracket on to bass drum. Adjust the height and tighten the wing nut on the bass drum bracket to secure the cymbal post.



The Drumset is now ready to be played!!!
