## Joanne's Hanging and wall pot and spice rack installation suggestions

The following is instructions for installation of screw type ceiling hooks.



It is necessary to install the ceiling screw hooks directly into the ceiling joists if possible. It is probably easiest to locate the ceiling joists with a stud finder. Most of my pot racks have chain brackets that can be located in various locations on the rack, which can help in fine tuning the final position.

Generally a rack will be centered between the joists. The stud finder will indicate the ceiling joist position allowing the installer to determine whether the joist location is correct for proper rack positioning.

**If your ceiling joists are not in the proper place to align your pot rack where you want it then you may want to go into the attic to add some 2 by 4's or 2x6's directly above the desired hook location. Mark the spot on your ceiling where the hooks need to go. You can then pre drill your pilot holes through the sheet rock from underneath. If your ceiling joists are there in the right place then just screw your ceiling hooks into the ceiling joists. If not you can easily locate the point(s) where the extra reinforcement needs to be by pushing a piece of wire through the holes (where the hooks need to be) to help you find the holes while you are in the attic.**

**Go into the attic with a tape measure and find your pilot holes. You will need to install the reinforcing boards where the wire is. Measure what length your 2 by's will need to be. Cut your 2 by's to length and then place them in the attic above the pilot holes. You can then fasten your 2 by's into place by nailing or screwing through the sides of the existing ceiling joists into the ends of the 2 by's. Two screws or nails about 3 to 4 inches long on each end should be adequate.**

**If the ceiling joists are in the right location then you can mark where the four ceiling hooks will be located. Make sure it's squared and centered to desired position over the island, bar, stove or counter.**

**Pre-drill pilot holes for the hooks then screw the ceiling screw hooks into the joists. You may need to use a pair of pliers or screwdriver for leverage to screw the hooks into the joists.**

**Install the chain to the chain hanger brackets furnished with the rack.**



**Attach your chains to the pot rack as pictured, then connect the other end of the pot rack chain to the ceiling screw hooks. It is probably easier to connect both chains on one end first, then attach the chains on the other end of the rack to the ceiling screw hooks.**

**Height adjustment can be changed by hooking the chains shorter on the ceiling screw hooks. Excess chain can be removed and discarded if desired.**

## **How to install my wall pot, pan, lid, spice, bookshelf racks**



**Wall brackets should be fastened to the wall studs for the most secure installation.**

**The wall brackets can be positioned anywhere on the rack. This allow positioning of the rack in relation to the position of the wall studs**
